We will show the following five short movies:

1. Polygoon filmjournaal "Nederland 1963", speciaal vervaardigd voor Actie Samen (Nederlandse tekst met Engelse onderschriften)
2. Rotterdam, gekleurd, Engelse tekst
3. "Over glas gesproken" gekleurd, Nederlandse tekst
4. "LIMBURG, gekleurd, Nederlandse tekst
5. Deltawerken, gekleurd, Engelse tekst

The combined running time for all five movies is two hours.

We had announced in previous bulletins that we would hold this event on November 6; however, the unavailability of a suitable auditorium on that date has forced us to postpone this event until Friday, November 13, at 8:00 p.m. SHARP. Since all proceeds of the evening are going to the STICHTING, we have been very fortunate in obtaining, at no charge, the big Recreation Room in "Oberholzer Hall" on the Campus of the University of Houston. The entrance to this Hall is on Wheeler Street, and we should use Parking Lot no. 10, right across the street from Oberholzer Hall.

As you can see from the titles of the movies, this promises to be a very interesting evening. Since part of the movies are spoken in English, we feel that many of our American friends might want to join us that evening. Therefore, we count on all of our members to spread the word and bring as many friends as possible. Oberholzer Hall can accommodate about 350 people, SO LET'S GET OUT THE WORD.

REMEMBER, THE MORE PEOPLE, THE MORE MONEY WE CAN TURN OVER TO THE STICHTING ACTIE SAMEN.

It also has occurred to us that some interest may be found in the schools. For that, naturally, we depend ON YOU, PARENTS.

Before closing, we publish below an announcement received from our Consulate-General.

" A Netherlands-Indonesian Committee has been established to investigate the rights of Dutch Nationals and Dutch corporate bodies on fixed property in West New-Guinea. In order to enable to Committee to make an inventory of those rights, parties concerned are requested to register by post-card with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Plein 23, The Hague, giving under the heading "Rechten West Nieuw-Guinea" name and address. After receipt of the postcards forms will be mailed to the senders on which further information concerning the rights can be given. The opportunity to register is open until December 31, 1964. For administrative reasons it is not possible to take into consideration registrations received before the date of publication (October 7, 1964) of this bulletin, or after December 31, 1964. "
