An announcement from the Consulate General of the Netherlands reads as follows:

Aan het complex van wetten en voorzieningen voor Nederlanders, die slachtoffers zijn van de oorlog 1940-1945 heeft de Nederlandse Regering onder de naam "Rijks-groepsregeling Vervolgings-slachtoffers 1940-1945" onlangs een nieuwe regeling toegevoegd.

Deze regeling, die uitsluitend bedoeld is voor Nederlanders, met inbegrip van bipatriden en de nabestaanden van Nederlanders, die om redenen van ras, geloof of wereldbeschouwing tijdens de bezetting van Nederland en het voormalige Nederlands-Indië werden vervolgd, is er in het bijzonder op gericht om door aanvullende uitkeringen - binnen redelijke grenzen - het levenspeil te behouden of te herstellen, waarop de betrokkenen voorheen leefden of zouden hebben geleefd, indien zij niet door de vervolging zouden zijn getroffen.
