## **Apple Roll-Ups**

(An Easter brunch dessert)

4 cups finely chopped, peeled tart apple 1/3 cup orange juice
1 tbsp lower-fat margarine
1 ½ tsp lemon juice
2 tbsp granulated sugar
2 tbsp brown sugar
2 tbsp. flour
½ tsp cinnamon
6 9" packaged crepes
¾ cup shredded low-fat cheddar cheese
Reddi-wip fat free whipped topping

More details will follow next week, but in the meantime visit Nature Conservancy for more info.

In a medium saucepan, combine apples and orange juice. Bring to a boil; reduce heat. Cover and cook over medium heat for 10 minutes. Stir in margarine and lemon juice. In a small bowl, combine next four ingredients; add to apple mixture. Cook and stir until thickened and bubbly; cook and stir 1 minute more. Spoon 1/3 cup apple mixture onto each crepe. Sprinkle 2 tbsp cheese on top and pipe Reddi-wip down center of each crepe. Roll up, garnish with Reddi-wip and serve warm. Makes 6 servings. Enjoy!!
